A celebration of the genius of the great English Renaissance composer, William Byrd, during this, the 400thyear anniversary of his death. Having composed only three settings of the mass ordinary, Byrd displays most perfectly his recusant Catholic heart in the triumphant setting of his *Mass for Five Voices*: "O Lord, Make thy Servant Elizabeth".

ABOUT THE ARTISTS

Vox Fidelis, founded in 2005 by its director, Timothy Smith, is a professional chamber choir specializing in sacred Renaissance choral music. Vox performs not only on the concert stage, but also in originally intended liturgical services including Sung Mass, Evensong, Compline & Benediction, Vespers, and Lessons & Carols. Vox Fidelis is Choir-in-Residence at Christ Church, Bordentown, New Jersey, where it presents a monthly Compline series. Vox performs regularly throughout the tri-state area. They have toured the Mid-Atlantic and Northeastern regions of the United States and have also performed several fringe concerts at the Boston Early Music Festival.

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life: who proceeds from the Father and the Son. With the Father and the Son he is worshipped and glorified; he has spoken through the Prophets.

I believe in one holy, catholic and apostolic Church. I acknowledge one baptism for the forgiveness of sins. And I look for the resurrection of the dead. And the life of the world to come. Amen.
